

Lent/Easter Mission Opportunity: Disaster Relief for Hurricane Helene and California Wildfires

Hurricanes and wildfires: we often watch in horror and disbelief, searching for ways that we can provide financial assistance that guarantee that our gifts will reach the people in need. We have found a way!

In March and April, we invite you to help raise funds that we will forward to the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). This disaster relief organization currently has "boots on the ground" in communities impacted by Hurricane Helene in the southeastern portion of the US and communities impacted by the wildfires in California. 100% of every dollar sent to UMCOR goes directly to relief efforts for those in need. Nothing is withheld for administrative fees.

We will divide all donations received @ 50/50 between Hurricane Relief and Wildfire Relief.

If you would like to contribute, please note "UMCOR" on your check or offering envelope, and place your donation in the white "offering coffeepot" at the back of the sanctuary. Checks should be made out to Blooming Grove UMC.

In addition, add your loose change to the "Shaker Can" at the back of the sanctuary. All "Shaker Can" collections will go to this mission project as well!

Watch as our Hymn of Promise Easter Garden Mural in the south addition bursts forth with signs of spring and hope – one new flower or sprig of grass, butterfly or bird, little creature or Easter egg, for each \$10 raised! "It matters that we become the Hands and feet for God. When People are suffering the most from Loss, we ask no questions. But in God's name, try to provide a little Hope and relief from their pain."

How does UMCOR provide help? They work with local United Methodist Conferences impacted by Hurricane Helene and the California wildfires in the following ways:

- Help fund and provide immediate evacuee support through distribution of food, water, essential supplies, and hygiene and cleaning kits.
- When it is safe to do so, UMCOR emergency response teams assist with removal of debris and cleanup.
- Provide grants for immediate response needs, as well as for long-term recovery needs.
- If requested, partner with the local United Methodist Conferences for several years in the planning, coordinating, and work needed for long-term recovery.
